After further discussion the Board informed Ms. Johnson that they would take care of the road as soon as the weather breaks and the road could be worked on.

Dudley Gardner met this day with the Board with an update of the Centennial Committee's report on the progress with the renovation of the Reliance Tipple. He also requested that additional monies be set aside in the up coming budget for future projects that the Centennial Committee will need. The Board informed Mr. Gardner that specific projects and dollar amounts would have to be given to the Board before the monies could be approved.

Charles Love met this day with the Board of Commissioners regarding the dinosaur project, requesting that the County sponsor county funds toward the project. After a discussion the Board informed Mr. Love that they would give his request consideration and would let him know their decision at a later date.

Fred Radosevich was opposed to the agreement and motion.

Bud Spelman, Mayor of the Town of Superior, met this day with the Board regarding the transportation of meals from Rock Springs Senior Citizens Center to the Superior Senior Citizens Center. After a discussion the Board suggested that Mayor Spelman contact the Director of the Senior Citizens Center in Rock Springs for information and help regarding the transportation of the meals.
