Mr. James Reinard met this day with the Board regarding dogs at large in the Jamestown area. After a discussion, the Board of County Commissioners informed Mr. Reinard that the County was adopting a new Resolution regarding domestic animal at large. Also discussed was a abandoned mobile

home in Mr. Reinard's trailer court. Mr. Reinard was informed that the abandoned mobile home was being taken care of and they would let him know when he could move it off his property.

A motion was duly made by John L. Yerkovich, seconded by Fred Radosevich and carried that the minutes of the April 5, 1989, the plat of Lost Security Ranch, be corrected to add the following wording to the motion:

The Board voted 3-0 to waive the dedication of land requirement (or fees-in-lieu of) since Mr. Hruska was being required by the City of Rock Springs to build the cul-de-sac to city standards. The paving and curb and gutter not required by the County were determined by the Board to fulfill the purpose of the dedication requirement.

Bud Spillman, Mayor of the Town of Superior, met this day with the Board requesting \$10,000.00 PILT monies for the Town's 1989-90 fiscal budget year from the County. Mr. Spillman was informed that the Town of Superior would be given consideration.

Sandy Dolak, Wyoming Health Initiative, met this day with the Board regarding funds for Wyoming Health Initiative Teen Pregnancy Program. After a discussion of the program, the Board informed Ms. Dolak that they would take her request for funds under consideration.

Larry Paine, Undersheriff, met this day with the Board regarding a proposal for a new computer system for the Sheriff's Office. After a discussion of the system, the Board informed Mr. Paine that they would take his request under consideration.

At this time, Chairman Linda M. Taliaferro called for an executive meeting per the request of the Sheriff's Department, regarding personnel matters.

After the executive meeting the Chairman re-opened the regular meeting of the Board. The Board at this time met with the County's elected officials regarding employees salaries. After various input received from the elected officials, it was felt that until assessed valuation figures were determined, nothing could be decided regarding salaries for County employees. The Board stated they would continue to work with the elected officials and would take their comments under advisement.

The Board of County Commissioners re-convened this day to complete all business on hand.

Kena Volsic came before the Board to request assistance in establishing a day activity program for lower functioning children and young adults. She noted that the need for such a program had been discussed with Southwest Wyoming Rehabilitation Center, with funding being the main problem. The Board advised that they would look into the matter.

Committee members and terms were announced for the newly formed Sweetwater County Transit Authority. Members included Dee Kenison, a three year term; Jim Forrest, a three term; Gary Bailiff, a two year term; Jay Lyon, a two year term and one unnamed member to be appointed to a one year term. Commissioner Fred Radosevich was named an ex-officio member.

John T. Nelson, Wayne Gudgeall and Phil Trenary of the Engineering Department met with the Board to up-date them on various on-going projects.

John L. Yerkovich moved that Resolution No. 89-05-03-01 authorizing the County Engineer to proceed with necessary documents for the vacation of the alley adjacent to the east line of Lots 2 and 3, Block 3 in Reliance, Wyoming. The motion was seconded by Fred Radosevich and carried.

Fred Radosevich moved that Resolution No. 89-05-03-02 authorizing the County Engineer to prepare necessary documents for vacation of County road No. 4-56, Lozier Ranch Road. John L. Yerkovich seconded and the motion carried.

A work order and supplement agreement with the Wyoming Highway Department regarding Foothill Boulevards and Stagecoach Boulevards was reviewed by the Board. A motion was duly made by John L. Yerkovich authorizing the Chairman to sign said agreement. Fred Radosevich seconded and the motion carried.

Mr. Jordan Rosen, Director and Representative from the Southwest Counseling Service, met this day with the Board of County Commissioners asking for a letter of support to the State of Wyoming for a grant for funding for a residential substance abuse center in Sweetwater County. After a discussion of the program, the Board felt that such a program would be worthwhile in Sweetwater County and compliment the Task Force and Mr. Rosen for the hard work and research that had gone into the report submitted to the Board of County Commissioners and at this time a motion was duly made by John

L. Yerkovich, seconded by Fred Radosevich and unanimously carried that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to write a letter of support as requested.

A motion was duly made by John L. Yerkovich, seconded by Fred Radosevich and carried that the following Resolution be approved:

RESOLUTION 89 - 2

WHEREAS the Sweetwater County Planning and Zoning Commission has recommended the approval of the zone change request by U.S. Zeolites, Inc. from A (Agricultural) to MD-1 (Mineral Development) for the purpose of stockpiling natural zeolite on the following described real property located adjacent to Bitter Creek, Wyoming:

Lot 2 in the SW/4 of the NE/4 of Section 10, Township 18 North, Range 99 West, Sweetwater County, Wyoming

A motion was duly made by John L. Yerkovich, seconded by Fred Radosevich and carried that Lisa Portillo, Derek G. Seeke and John P. Watterson be awarded County Commissioners Scholarships either to the University of Wyoming or a Wyoming Junior College of their choice in the State of Wyoming for the school year of 1989-90 and Gary Okano be awarded the renewal County Commissioners Scholarship to the University of Wyoming for the school year 1989-90.

A motion was duly made by John L. Yerkovich, seconded by Fred Radosevich and carried that the Fire Protection Agreement between the City of Rock Springs and Sweetwater County be approved and signed.

Mr. Don Boyer from the Board of Charities and Reform and Mr. Mickey Gamble, Riverton Honor Farm, met this day with the Board regarding a adult Community Correction Program in Sweetwater County. The facility would house 25-30 inmates who are preparing for release from the State Prison after serving sentences for nonviolent felony crimes and would house diversionals who are sentenced to the facility rather than the State Prison. Mr. Boyer explained to the Board that the County would benefit as twelve additional jobs would be added to the County. Also if the Board of County Commissioners would approve the facility by resolution the Commissioners would then appoint a nine member board and this board would set all rules for the facility and determine which prisoners would be accepted. Funds would come from the State and there would be no cost to the County. After further discussion, the Board informed Mr. Boyer and Gamble that they would take their request under advisement and would first call for a public hearing to hear public comment before any decision is made regarding the proposal.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, the meeting was adjourned subject to the call of it's Chairman.
