Yerkovich, seconded by Fred Radosevich and carried that the bid be awarded to Kemp Motor Co, the apparent low bidder, following the perusal of said bid by Bill Matthews, County Fire Marshall. Mr. Matthews later returned, stating that Kemp Motors had not met all specifications. John L. Yerkovich moved to rescind his earlier motion due to questions raised regarding the specifications and to recall bids. Fred Radosevich seconded and the motion carried.

John T. Nelson and Wayne Gudgeall of the County Engineering Department met with the Board to update them on various on-going projects. The possibility of moving a portion of the Superior Cutoff Road approximately fifteen feet to the north, away from Superior's waterline, was discussed with Superior's Mayor, Bud Spillman.

A proposed frontage road off of Yellowstone Road was discussed, after which Fred Radosevich moved that a right-of-way be obtained from Paul Zancanella and that the remainder of Yellowstone Road be fenced on both sides. The motion was seconded by John L. Yerkovich and carried.

The Engineers also reported their findings regarding leakage of the County's vehicle maintenance shop roof, stating an estimated cost of \$33,00.00. It was moved by Fred Radosevich, seconded by John L. Yerkovich and carried that the Engineers proceed with bid specifications for this project.

Superior Mayor, Bud Spillman requested assistance from the County for materials to help stabilize the Town's sewer lagoon; to bring an intersection to grade; and to fence a cemetery. The Board agreed to look into the matters.
