E.S. McKay, M.D. and County Health Officer, met this day with the Board. Dr. McKay explained to the board that his department has received various requests outside Sweetwater County to test water samples. He stated that he had no problem in doing the water sample test but felt a \$5.00 fee should be charged and requested the Board's approval to enter into a contract with the various agencies outside of Sweetwater County, to do the water testing. Following a discussion, a motion was duly made by John L. Yerkovich, seconded by Fred Radosevich and carried that permission be granted for Dr. McKay's department to do the water testing and the Board would enter and sign the various contracts involved.

Julie Gillett and Jim Carrol, U.S. West Communications, met this day with the Board to discuss the Enhanced 911 Service offered by U.S. West Communications. It was explained to the Board that the Basic 911 Systems are limited as they only provide a central answering point and since people are not always calm in emergency situations a many times communication is difficult. The Enhanced 911 System was build to address this problem with the main advantage being that the system is much faster and can collect more information from the caller and immediately compare it with a data base of emergency information.

The Board was informed that the 1989 Wyoming Legislature approved a surcharge, up to fifty cents on each telephone line, to assist with the cost of the emergency service. After further discussion, the Board informed the two U.S. West Communication representatives that they would give their presentation consideration.

Doug O'Brien, Northpark Elementary School Principal, met this day with the Board regarding the possibility of the County authorizing a crosswalk guard for approximately two hours per school day at the Northpark Elementary School. Following a discussion, the Board informed Mr. O'Brien that they would give his request consideration and would get back to him with their decision.

Representatives from the Town of Wamsutter met this day with the Board requesting assistance from the Board to use the County Engineer to help design a sewer system for the Town of Wamsutter and also requested paving of a road which has heavy traffic south of the Town. The Commissioners informed the representatives that they would have the County Engineer look into the matter of the road and the sewer design, but felt that the County would not be able to pave the

road but suggest that lignon sulfonate be used to hold down the dust. The representatives also requested assistance in helping the Town pay for it's law officer should the 1990 census go down in that area. The Board took the request under advisement.

At this time the Chairman, Linda M. Taliaferro, called for an executive session with the County Attorney regarding personnel matters.

Following the executive meeting, the Chairman re-opened the regular meeting of the Board.
