This being the day as advertised, a public hearing was held regarding a Technical Assistance Grant from Community Development Block Grant/Economic Development Program. Ed Hammer, Director of the American Dicalcaum Phosphate Technical Corp., came before the Board with an application in the amount of \$9,000.00 for the purpose of studying the feasibility of developing a Dicalcaium Phosphate processing operation in Sweetwater County. Mr. Hammer explained the process by which they manufacture an animal feed supplement, and also a possibility of using gypsum, a by-product of the operation, in the manufacture of paperless wallboard. Den Costantino, Chairman of the Sweetwater Economic Development Association, also addressed the Board and asked several question of Mr. Hammer. It was moved by John L. Yerkovich, seconded by Fred Radosevich and carried that the application be accepted as presented and that the following Resolution be adopted.

### R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the State of Wyoming Economic Development and Stabilization Board has made funds available for Technical Assistance Grants through the Community Development Block Grant/Economic Development Program; and

WHEREAS, Technical Assistance Grants are available for the purpose of funding feasibility studies which will enable businesses to better determine the viability of certain projects; and

WHEREAS, American Dicalcium Phosphate Technical Corporation, Washington, D.C., has made application for a Technical Assistance Grant of \$9,000.00 for the purpose studying the feasibility of developing a Dicalcium Phosphate processing operation in Sweetwater County, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, the Sweetwater County Board of Commissioners desires to assist American Dicalcium Phosphate Technical Corporation by sponsoring its application for a \$9,000.00 Technical Assistance Grant to the Economic Development and Stabilization Board; and

WHEREAS, the Sweetwater County Board of Commissioners agrees to administer the \$9,000.00 Technical Assistance Grant funds; now

THEREFORE, the Sweetwater County Board of Commissioners, meeting on November 7, 1989, hereby sponsors and endorses this application for a \$9,000.00 grant to the Economic Development and Stabilization Board for purpose of funding a dicalcium phosphate processing feasibility study; and agrees to administer the funds.
