Following the executive session, the Chairman re-opened the regular meeting of the Board.

A motion was duly made by John L. Yerkovich, seconded by Fred Radosevich and carried that the variance received from Sweetwater Federal Savings and Loan Association, being Lot 2, Block 2, Clark Subdivision, Sweetwater County, Wyoming be denied, per the recommendation of the Planning Commission.

After hearing pros and cons from various concerned property owners and a letter received from Billee Jelouchan regarding a public hearing to delete in Section 4f.(1) of the Zoning Resolution in reference to the "R-2/SF" District so as not to allow a mobile home in the R-2/SF District as a second residence on a temporary basis in hardship cases or in any other instances as authorized under Section 4f. of the Sweetwater County Zoning Resolution. After further discussion and review, a motion was duly made by John L. Yerkovich, seconded by Fred Radosevich and unanimously carried that the following Resolution be approved and amended:

RESOLUTION 89 - 17

WHEREAS the Sweetwater County Planning and Zoning Commission after holding a duly advertised public hearing in accordance with procedural requirements of the Zoning Resolution of Sweetwater County, Wyoming, has recommended and certified that following text amendment to the Zoning Resolution as initiated by Billee Jelouchan and Larry Caller, citizens of Sweetwater County, Wyoming:

DELETE in Section 4f.(1) of the Zoning Resolution reference to the "R-2/SF" District so as not to allow a mobile home in the R-2/SF District as a second residence on a temporary bases in hardship cases or in any other instances as authorized under Section 4f. of the Zoning Resolution.

WHEREAS the recommended and certified text amendment to the Zoning Resolution is consistent with the purposes and goals of the adopted Sweetwater County Comprehensive and Land Use Plans and would be adopted pursuant to the provision of Chapter 5, Section 18-5-201 through 18-5-207, Wyoming Statutes Annotated, 1977 Republished Edition, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the aforementioned text amendment to the Zoning Resolution of Sweetwater County, Wyoming, be adopted and incorporated into said law.

Unanimously approved this 6th day of December 1989.

AMENDED 12/6/89: The recommendation was approved; however the second mobile home located on Lot 48, Mountaineer 3rd (Robert Hamilton) will not be affected by this change in the zoning language.
