The Board of County Commissioners met this day in special session, as advertised for a public hearing, to hear public comment to consider adopting a resolution to establish a uniform charge in an amount not to exceed fifty cents (\$.50) on each local exchange access line for the 911 emergency telephone system to be provided in Sweetwater County.

There were no objections from the concern citizens in attendance and those in favor of the system asked various questions concerning the operation of the system. After further discussion, the Board took under advisement the consideration of adopting a resolution to install the enhanced 911 system at it's next meeting of February, 1990.

At this time, Linda M. Taliaferro, Chairman of the Board, called for an executive meeting to discuss possible litigation. No action was taken. Following the executive meeting, the Chairman re-opened the special meeting of the Board. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned subject to the call of it's Chairman.
