Jack Zimmerman, Emergency Management, met this day with the Board of County Commissioners with a proposal for the County Fire Warden position that will soon be vacant. Mr. Zimmerman felt that the Fire Warden position could be combined within his department, Emergency Management Agency, and gave various reasons why his proposal would be beneficial to Sweetwater County. After further discussion, the Board thanked Mr. Zimmerman for his proposal and stated that the Board had not made any decision as to the vacancy at this time.

Representatives from the Task Force on Sexual Assault met this day with the Board regarding the combining of three crisis lines being utilized by three different Human Resources agencies into one crisis line. The representatives felt that this would not be beneficial for their department because of the nature of the calls that their department receives and cost affectiveness. After further discussion, it was suggested by the Board of County Commissioners that a meeting be held with the three Human Resources agencies involved to explore the suggestion further and make a decision at that time.

Upon the recommendation of E.S. McKay, M.D., County Health Officer, Jean A. Stachon, M.D., was appointed Assistant Health Officer.

R E S O L U T I O N

A RESOLUTION ORDERING INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL REAL PROPERTY INTO THE INTER CITY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, SWEETWATER COUNTY, WYOMING.

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the Sweetwater County Clerk a Resolution ordering the inclusion of additional real property into the Inter City Water and Sewer District, Sweetwater County, Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, it appears from the record of proceedings of the Board of Directors of the Inter City Water and Sewer District that all requirements imposed by Wyoming law for the inclusion of real property into a water and sewer district have been complied with by said Board.
