Being the day as advertised, a public hearing was held regarding a grant application being submitted to the Economic and Community Development Board for \$109,500.00 for the purchase and renovation of a facility for inpatient substance abuse treatment. Comments made in favor of the application came from Ray Lovato who indicated that the Rock Springs Community Development Commission was supportive of the grant. Unfavorable comments were made by Sophie Lemich. Jordan Rosen, Director of the Southwest Counseling Service responded to her questions. John L. Yerkovich stated that due to a conflict of interest he would not vote regarding the application. Fred Radosevich moved to adopt the following resolution. Linda M. Taliaferro seconded and motion carried.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the residents of Sweetwater County have identified the need for a facility for inpatient substance abuse treatment; and

WHEREAS, 50% of the Department of Public Assistance and Social Service cases in Sweetwater County involve alcohol and other drugs and 70% of child abuse cases are drug/alcohol related; and

WHEREAS, Southwest Counseling Service has proposed to purchase and renovate a facility to provide inpatient substance abuse treatment; and

WHEREAS, the Economic and Community Development Board of the State of Wyoming is accepting applications under the Community Development Block Grant program, and

WHEREAS, the goals of the Community Development Block Grant Program include "Goal 3: Meet other community development needs having a particular emergency because existing conditions pose an immediate and serious threat to the health and/or welfare of the community where other resources are not available to meet such needs", and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on August 7, 1990, regarding Sweetwater County's application for Community Development Block Grant funds, now

THEREFORE, the Board of Sweetwater County Commissioners approves the submittal of an application to the Economic and Community Development Board for \$109,500.00 for the purchase and renovation of a facility to be located in Sweetwater County, and authorized the Chair of the Board to sign the application.
