Don Baumberger, member of the Fine Arts Center, met this day with the Board regarding a proposal to set up a committee to do a feasibility study on whether the Fine Arts Center could become a separate entity. After a discussion the Board requested Mr. Baumberger to draw up guidelines regarding a budget, number of board members appointed and who would make the appointments and present the guidelines to the Board of County Commissioners at the next regular meeting in May of 1991.

A motion was duly made by Linda M. Taliaferro, seconded by Larry Caller and carried that Jack Zimmerman, Emergency Management Coordinator, be allowed to start the legal advertisement for the call of bids for an architect/engineer service to design an Emergency Operation Center (EOC) in the basement level of Western Wyoming College in Rock Springs, Wyoming, which will be grant funded.
