A motion was duly made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that the Enhanced 911 Network Service Agreement between U.S. West Communication and Sweetwater County be signed by the Acting Chairman, Linda M. Taliaferro.

This being the day as advertised for the issuance of a Retail Malt Beverage Permit to J.C. Kilburn Co., d/b/a Table Rock Service and there being no protest against the issuance of said Retail Malt Beverage Permit a motion was duly made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that said Retail Malt Beverage Permit be approved.

A motion was duly made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that the County Clerk be instructed to start the legal advertisement for the transfer of a Retail Liquor License from Ronald J. Quintal d/b/a Log Inn to Kenneth J. Henley d/b/a Log Inn.

A motion was duly made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that Johnson Fermelia Company, Inc. be awarded the contract to provide the service of preliminary architectural design and cost estimates for the Alternate State Emergency Operations Center to be located at Western Wyoming College.

A motion was duly made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that Acting Chairman be authorized to sign the memorandum of understanding between the State of Wyoming and Sweetwater County, Wyoming, for the continuous operations of a State Alternate Emergency Operation Center.

A motion was duly made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that the memorandum of understanding between the University of Wyoming and Sweetwater County, Wyoming be signed by the Acting Chairman for Cooperative Extension Work.

Members of the Youth Home met this day with the Board requesting funding in the 1991-92 fiscal year budget to build a new facility to be used as a Crisis Center to provide a better alternative to juvenile detention. After a discussion, the Board informed the members of the Youth Home that they could not make a commitment regarding funding at this time since the monies may not be available in the budget, but they were in favor of the project and would continue to work with them. The Board asked that they met with the BLM regarding the time limit required for building on the land in question.

A motion was duly made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that the following Proclamation be approved:
