The Board of County Commissioners met this day in regular session with all members present. A motion was duly made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that the minutes from the previous meeting be approved as read.

The Board of County Commissioners met this day with various Sweetwater County agencies, being the Sweetwater County Fair, Sweetwater County Library, Sweetwater County Museum and Southwest Counseling Service, to discuss budgets for the 1991-92 fiscal year.

Don Baumberger, Superintendent School District #1, and Gary Greenhalgh, Attorney for the School District, met this day with the Board regarding the Community Fine Arts Center's budget and the possibility of incorporating the Fine Arts Center into the Sweetwater County Library System under the direction of the Library Board. After further discussion, the Board agreed to consult the City of Rock Springs concerning their share of funding before a decision is made.

Zoda Ferguson, Court Clerk Sweetwater County Court System in Rock Springs, met this day with the Board regarding computer workstations for the court system. After a discussion, the Board agreed to contact a local supplier for quotations.

The Board of County Commissioners met this day with various Human Resource agencies, being V.I.R.S., Y.W.C.A., Family Planning, Youth Home, Hospice, Child Developmental Center, Task Force on Sexual Assault, S.W.R.C. and Big Brothers/Big Sisters, to explain that there would have to be budget cuts within their departments and to request that they all cut their budgets for the 1991-92 fiscal year back to the 1990-91 fiscal year amounts. The Board also explained the Robin Hood Bill and stated that if this bill goes through at the next legislature session, it would be possible that compatible Human Resources agencies would be put under one directorship and some of the services now provided could be cut.

Albert Emden, Sweetwater County Sanitation, met his day with the Board of County Commissioners regarding maintenance of the public health building in Green River. After a discussion the Board informed Mr. Emden that they would work something out to provide maintenance for the Public Health Department Building.

Ronald R. Johnson, Director Small Business Development Center of Western Wyoming Community College, met this day with the Board requesting that the Board of County Commissioners sponsor a Community Development Block Grant. Following further discussion, a motion was duly made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that Sweetwater County sponsor the grant.

Paul Zancanella, D.V.M., and Gary Bailiff, Sweetwater County Sheriff, met this day with the Board regarding the leasing of a building from Dr. Zancanella for animal control that will be supervised by the Sheriff's Department. It was agreed at this time that the County of Sweetwater would enter into a one year lease with Dr. Zancanella for the building.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned subject to the call of it's Chairman.
