LODGING TAX RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION IMPOSING AN EXCISE TAX UPON
SALES OF LODGING SERVICES AS SET FORTH IN
WYO. STAT. 5 39-6-412 (b) (ii) (1977, AS
AMENDED), FOR THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF PROMO-
TION OF LOCAL TRAVEL AND TOURISM.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER OF THE COUNTY OF SWEETWATER, STATE OF WYOMING:

Section 1. This Resolution shall be known, and may be cited, as the Sweetwater County Lodging Tax Resolution.

Section 2. From and after the effective date of this Resolution, within the limitation herein set out, there is hereby imposed and there shall be collected and paid an excise tax upon every sale of lodging services; as provided for in Wyo. Stat. 5 39-6-412(b)(ii) (1977, as amended) and defined in Wyo. Stat. 5 39-6-402(a)(xi) (1977, as amended), made within the County of Sweetwater, State of Wyoming, at a rate of 2% of the sale price paid therefore.

Section 3. Insofar as they relate to sales taxes, Wyo. Stat. 5 39-6-401 through 5 39-6-417 (1977, as amended), and Wyo. Stat. 5 39-5-101 (1977, as amended), are incorporated herein by reference, and made a part hereof, except that the County of Sweetwater, State of Wyoming shall be substituted for the State of Wyoming as the taxing agency, and an additional license shall not be required if one has been or is issued to the vendor under Wyo. Stat. 5 39-6-403 (1977, as amended).

Section 4. All amendments, subsequent to the effective date hereof, of the sections herein set forth in Section 3 relating to sales tax and not in conflict with this section or Wyo. Stat. 5 39-6-518 (1977) shall automatically become a part of the Sweetwater County Lodging Tax Resolution.

Section 5. The County of Sweetwater shall contract prior to the effective date of the Sweetwater County Lodging Tax Resolution with the State Tax Commission to perform all functions incident to the administration or operation of the Sweetwater County Lodging Tax Resolution.

Section 6. The amount subject to the tax imposed herein shall not include the amount of any sales tax or use tax imposed by the State of Wyoming.
