The Board of County Commissioners met this day at 8:00 P.M. to hold a public hearing, as advertised, on various budgets for the fiscal period ending June 30, 1992, with Fred Radosevich, Linda M. Taliaferro and Larry Caller present.

Approximately fifty (50) persons were present at the public hearing.

The meeting was called to order by it's Chairman, Fred Radosevich, and the following budgets were received and discussed:

General County
Mental Health
County Fair
County Library
County Museum
County Outdoor Recreation
City-County Airport
County Hospital

The Board heard comments from Karen Wendt, employee of the Memorial Hospital of Sweetwater County. Mrs. Wendt had concerns regarding the Board of County Commissioners decision to not give the hospital a mill levy for the fiscal budget year 1991-92. She stated that she thought it was the County of Sweetwater's obligation to fund for charity care.

Mrs. Wendt was informed by the Board that since the hospital had a reserve fund of over eight million dollars, the hospital should use it's reserve. After further discussion, the Board stated that if the hospital should ever get into a financial bind, the Board of County Commissioners would come to the hospital's aid.

As advertised, the Jamestown Fire District budget for the fiscal year 1991-92 was read and no comments were made regarding the budget.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 8:30 P.M. to re-convene the next day, July 16, 1991, at 10:00 A.M.

Due to the recent approval of the 2% Lodging Tax by electors of Sweetwater County and the subsequent establishment of a Joint Powers Board to assist in the administration of these funds, the Board randomly drew two towns who will now appoint representatives to the Joint Powers Board. The towns drawn were Wamsutter and Superior. In two years, representation will rotate to Bairoil and Granger, with a rotation taking place every two years.

A motion was made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that Jeri Jaspersen be appointed as the County's member of the Lodging Tax Joint Powers Board.

The Fine Arts Center was discussed and the County's appointments to this Board. It was moved by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that Linda M. Taliaferro, Jean Curran and Carol Shilling be appointed to this reorganized board.

Al Emden, County Sanitarian, met with the Board to discuss personnel matters.

At this time, the Chairman called for an executive session to discuss matters pertaining to personnel. Following the executive session, the Chairman reopened the regular meeting of the Board.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, the Board adjourned, subject to the call of it's Chairman.
