The Board of County Commissioners met this day in regular session with all members present. A motion was duly made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that the minutes of the previous meeting was approved as read.

A motion was duly made by Linda M. Taliaferro, seconded by Larry Caller and carried that Pitt Roofing, being the lowest bidder, be awarded the bid to install a new roof on the Sweetwater County Courthouse, in the amount of \$158,600.00.

A motion was duly made by Linda M. Taliaferro, seconded by Larry Caller and carried that the Resolution and Quitclaim Deed from Sweetwater County to the Town of Superior for the south 40 feet of Lot 9, Block 9, and the north 20.7 feet of Lot 10, Block 9, Superior Original Plat, be signed and delivered to the Town of Superior.

A motion was duly made by Larry Caller, seconded by Linda M. Taliaferro and carried that the Chairman be authorized to sign the license agreement between the U.S.A. (Bureau of Reclamation) and Sweetwater County, Wyoming, for the removal of existing piles of gravel, contract number 1-LM-40-00470, Sweetwater County, Wyoming, Seedskafee Project (Gravel Permit).

Mr. Ray Maple, Head of Public Safety, Town of Wamsutter, met this day with the Board to request the County's financial help in purchasing a fire truck. After a discussion, the Board informed Mr. Maple that they would consider his request.

Mr. Evertt Cassidy, Lincoln County Commissioner, met this day with the Board suggesting that Lincoln and Sweetwater County Commissioners write a joint letter to the Wyoming Highway Department, requesting that the State Highway System make the Exxon Road a state highway. It was agreed by the Sweetwater County Commissioners that such a letter be written to the State Highway Department.

Gayle Stewart, Deputy County Attorney, came before the Board to update them regarding the Lodging Tax Agreement, stating that the final form was awaiting response from the towns.

John Yarbrough, Hydrographer - Commissioner of the State Engineer's Office, met with the Board to discuss the agreements regarding the county water commissioners, there being some confusion as to the countys' responsibilities for salary. Mr. Yarbrough was able to clarify some points, but felt an additional meeting in September would allow time to gather further information.

At this time, the Chairman called for an executive session with Carl Samietz, Rock Springs Road and Bridge Foremen, to discuss personnel matters.

Following the executive session, the meeting was re-convened to complete business at hand.

Mr. Ron Johnson from the Small Business Development Center met this day with the Board, requesting that the Community Development Block Grant that was requested at the Board's meeting August 7, 1991, be withdrawn from consideration. The request was granted.

Wayne Gudgell, from the County Engineering Department, met with the Board to update them on the mapping project for the Assessor's Office.
