

Instructions

County License - Type B

The License Application is on the next page.

1. The fee for a County License - Type B is **\$50.00**. Payment can be made with either a check or a money order made payable to "Sweetwater County." A receipt will be mailed to the address on the application. **The license will not be approved without payment.**
2. This license is to be used for utilities that will cross a county road overhead, or will parallel the road for less than 1000 feet within the county road right-of-way. If the utility will be buried while crossing the road, or is paralleling the road for more than 1000 feet within the county road right-of-way, then a County License - Type A is required.
3. The minimum depth for a buried utility paralleling a county road is 3 1/2 feet.
4. Be sure to include a detailed site plan of the utility location. This site plan should include a profile of the road crossing showing the height of the suspended utility line, and a section tie with bearing and distance from the nearest section corner to the actual utility line crossing. All utility crossings must be perpendicular to the travelway centerline. If you have any questions, feel free to call the Sweetwater County Engineering Office at (307) 872-6485 or (307) 352-6713.

ATTACHMENT TO LICENSE

**FUTURE LOCATING
OF
LICENSED BURIED FACILITIES**

The Licensee agrees to locate and mark the facility being licensed in the following manner.

- A. The utility company or facility owner, as a condition of approval for the attached license, agrees to locate the facility identified by the license, when needed by the County Engineer for future construction and maintenance activities. This information will be the basis of plans prepared by the County Engineer for use by the County and the County's contractors. If Relocation of the identified facility is necessary to aid the County's work, reimbursement will be as provided for by law.

- B. Location information will include the marking of the facility on the ground, as specified by W.S. 37-12-302 et sep., with the appropriate color. Location information will also include the nature and elevation of the facility. For each location, the utility shall be tied both horizontally and vertically, by coordinates, to a datum determined by the County Engineer and certified by a licensed surveyor. The information will be shown on plans created by the utility company or facility owner. A copy of the plans will be sent to the County Clerk's Office. Costs associated with identifying and locating the facilities will be the responsibility of the company or facility owner on Department right-of-way.

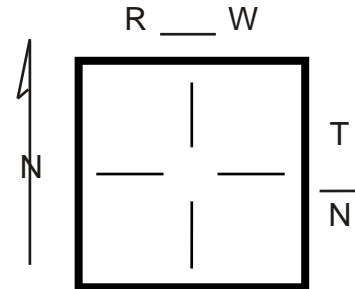

1. The utility facility will be placed in a manner to conform with recognized standards applicable Federal, State, or local laws, codes and ordinances and as directed by the County Engineer.
2. Any future alteration or modification of the Facility within the existing right of way, required and requested by the County, shall be completed without delay and cost to the County.
3. The alignment and grade, clearance, materials, pressures, land ties and mile post ties are shown on the plan sheet dated _____.
4. The License will not be modified, transferred or assigned without the consent of the County.
5. The Licensee agrees to conform to the standards for traffic control as outlined in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). The Licensee must cease all operations if the traffic control standards are not met.
6. To the extent of the licensee's negligence, therefore, the licensee agrees to forever indemnify the County and save it harmless from all liability for damage to property or injury to or death of persons, including all costs and expenses relating thereto, arising wholly or in part or in connection with the existence of construction, alterations, repairs, renewals, or uses or removals of the Facility as pertain to any County Road.
7. Right of way markers for buried utilities are required effective August 97.
