## Commissioner Comments/Reports

### Commissioner Van Matre

Commissioner Van Matre reported that he met with his normal liaisons. In addition, Commissioner Van Matre spoke that he attended a Joint Revenue Committee meeting in Cheyenne on October 28 & 29 and noted that it was a valuable experience. Commissioner Van Matre reported that he attended a Young at Heart Senior Citizens Center board meeting, met with School District #1 Superintendent Mathew Neal, and attended a Water District Study meeting in Farson. Commissioner Van Matre also noted that he attended a meeting at Western Wyoming Community College concerning the overall condition of the college which was very positive. Commissioner Van Matre met with VSO Director Larry Leavitt and noted that things are moving forward favorably. Commissioner Van Matre shared that Karen Bonomo invited the commission to attend a flag raising ceremony at the big flag pole in Rock Springs on Veteran's Day and that he would be speaking at the ceremony.

### Chairman Johnson

Chairman Johnson reported that he attended a CLG (Coalition of Local Governments) meeting in Rock Springs with BP primarily concerning financial support for CLG efforts. Chairman Johnson shared that Wamsutter is the largest onshore project of BP. Chairman Johnson spoke that he attended a regular monthly meeting of the CLG noting that a major issue was to know which roads, if any, the BLM intends to abandon and close as well as the continuing issue of sage grouse. Chairman Johnson noted that the commission was asked to draft a letter of support for the Rock Springs Chamber of Commerce Visitors Center Grant Application Project and spoke that Grants Manager Krisena Marchal prepared this letter.

*Commissioner West moved to proceed with sending the letter of support for the Chamber of Commerce expansion and the grant application in Rock Springs. Commissioner Bailiff seconded the motion.* The motion carried.

### Commissioner West

Commissioner West reported that he attended a dinner sponsored by the Petroleum Association of Wyoming and noted that Sweetwater county was well represented. Commissioner West shared issues with the Health and Human Services Building. Commissioner West reported that he also attended the Western Wyoming Community College Peer Review Dinner for accreditation of the college. Commissioner West noted that he met with Castle Rock Hospital District, attended a hospital Finance and Audit Committee meeting and met with Southwest Counseling Service and commended new board appointments. Commissioner West noted that he served on a subcommittee for the County Commissioners' Association regarding public health nursing. Lastly, Commissioner West reported that the Rock Springs CDC building is close to receiving a final occupation permit.

### Commissioner Bailiff

Commissioner Bailiff reported that he attended a meeting with the fire warden and his assistant regarding a future workshop. Commissioner Bailiff noted that he met with Road and Bridge regarding issues with theft and damage. Commissioner Bailiff also reported that he met with the Ambulance board.

## County Resident Concerns

Chairman Johnson opened county resident concerns. Resident Eva Wasseen appeared to request that a bus shelter be placed in her subdivision north of Rock Springs on Lakota Drive. Chairman Johnson indicated that she should contact Land Use Director Eric Bingham regarding this issue. Hearing no further comments, the hearing was closed.

Following discussion, *Commissioner Bailiff moved to nominate Lance Pace. Commissioner West seconded the motion.* The motion carried.

**Resolution to Appoint Circuit Court Magistrates**

Circuit Court Judge Prokos requested authorization to appoint additional part-time magistrates to serve the Circuit Court for the Third Judicial District, Sweetwater County, to serve in both Green River and Rock Springs. Following discussion, *Commissioner West moved to appoint Thomas O. Deering, Daniel Erramouspe and Jason Petri as part-time magistrates to serve the District Court. Commissioner Van Matre seconded the motion.* The motion carried.

**Approval of the Letter to WYDOT for the FFY 2013 DSP Grant Program**

Grants Manager Krisena Marchal presented and requested a motion to approve, and authorize the Chairman to sign, the Letter to WYDOT for the FFY 2013 DSP Grant Program. Following discussion, Chairman Johnson entertained a motion to approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the letter to WYDOT for the FFY 2013 DSP Grant Program. *Commissioner Van Matre so moved.* Receiving no second, the motion died.

**Approval of the Business Ready Community Grant Extension Letter**

Grants Manager Krisena Marchal presented and requested a motion to approve, and authorize the Chairman to sign, the Business Ready Community Grant Extension Letter for the Workforce Training Center at Western Wyoming Community College. Following discussion, Chairman Johnson entertained a motion to approve, and authorize the Chairman to sign, the Business Ready Community Grant Extension Letter for the Workforce Training Center at Western Wyoming Community College. *Commissioner West so moved. Commissioner Van Matre seconded the motion.* The motion carried.

**Break**

Chairman Johnson called for a fifteen minute break.

**Affiliation Agreement Approval Request**

Memorial Hospital of Sweetwater County CEO Jerry Klein, Castle Rock Hospital District CEO Bailie Dockter and Attorney George Lemich presented the affiliation agreement between Memorial Hospital and Castle Rock Hospital District. Mr. Lemich shared that the goal of this agreement is to improve access to and the quality and efficiency of health care in the community it serves. Deputy County Attorney Cliff Boevers noted that this is an example of where the county commission is involved in providing consent and approval. Following discussion, Chairman Johnson entertained a motion to approve the affiliation agreement as presented and to authorize the Chairman to sign the same. *Commissioner West so moved. Commissioner Van Matre seconded the motion.* The motion carried.

**Update from Castle Rock Hospital District and Request for County Assistance**

Castle Rock Hospital District CEO Bailie Dockter and CFO Todd Toolson were in attendance along with Castle Rock Board members Dan Stanton and Bob Gordon and Attorney George Lemich. Ms. Dockter and Mr. Toolson offered a presentation to update the commission on the district and ask for county support. Ms. Dockter noted that other options would be to ask for a general election ballot question to increase the mill levy and the possibility of privatization of the convalescent center and possibly the villa. A lengthy discussion ensued regarding possible solutions.

**Break**

Chairman Johnson called for a fifteen minute break.

**Fire Department Brush Truck Award**

Purchasing Manager Marty Dernovich presented the Sweetwater County vehicle bid opening for the Fire Department brush truck and recommended to award the bid for the 2014 Ford F350 Crew Cab to 1<sup>st</sup> Choice Ford of Rock Springs in the amount of \$41,923.00. Following discussion, *Commissioner West moved to approve the request. Commissioner Bailiff seconded the motion.* The motion carried.

**Approval of "Statewide Paved County Road Collection Plan"**

Public Works Director John Radosevich explained that the Wyoming County Commissioners Association Transportation Committee has recommended that all Wyoming counties approve the proposed Statewide Paved County Roads Data Collection Plan and authorize the chairman to sign any necessary documents. Following discussion, *Commissioner Bailiff moved to accept this and authorize the chairman to sign. Commissioner West seconded the motion.* The motion carried.

**Approval of BLM Right of Way Grant WYW167432 Amended**

Public Works Director John Radosevich presented the BLM Right of Way Grant/Temporary Use Permit WYW167432 amended and asked for approval and to authorize the Chairman to sign. Following discussion, *Commissioner Van Matre moved to approve the BLM Right of Way Grant/Temporary Use Permit WYW167432 as amended and authorize the chairman to sign. Commissioner Bailiff seconded the motion.* The motion carried.

**Approval of BLM Right of Way Grant WYW182628 (County Road 4-17 Chilton Road)**

Public Works Director John Radosevich presented the BLM Right of Way Grant/Temporary Use Permit WYW182628 and asked for approval and to authorize the Chairman to sign. Following discussion, *Commissioner West moved to approve the agreement. Commissioner Bailiff seconded the motion.* The motion carried.

**Request to add one Full Time Position and Eliminate one Seasonal Employee**

Public Works Director John Radosevich, Assistant Fire Warden Jessica Knezovich and Fire Warden Dave Bottemiller requested authorization to add one full time position and eliminate one seasonal position. Fire

Warden Bottemiller noted that this is primarily for safety issues. Following discussion, Chairman Johnson restated the request to add one full time position and eliminate one seasonal employee. ***Commissioner Bailiff moved to approve the request. Commissioner Van Matre seconded the motion.*** The motion carried.

**Request to Re-Staff Vacancy in Clerk's Office**

County Clerk Dale Davis requested authorization to re-staff an auto title clerk vacancy. Following discussion, ***Commissioner West moved to approve the request. Commissioner Van Matre seconded the motion.*** The motion carried.

**Request to Re-Staff Legal Assistant**

County Attorney Brett Johnson requested authorization to re-staff a legal assistant position. County Attorney Brett Johnson indicated that he has a part-time completely grant funded victim witness coordinator who might be interested in the position but that no decision has been made. Following discussion, ***Commissioner West moved to grant the request including the option that, if he ends up hiring the grant victim witness coordinator, that position can then be filled. Commissioner Bailiff seconded the motion.*** The motion carried.

**GAL Program**

County Attorney Brett Johnson updated the commission on the GAL Program. County Attorney Brett Johnson explained that the program is ready to start accepting cases and that it would now be appropriate for the commission to repurpose the money for the state GAL program. County Clerk Dale Davis noted that there was a budget amendment for these funds and that no action was needed by the commission since it would be funded under the same line item.

**Lunch**

Chairman Johnson recessed the meeting for lunch. After the lunch break, Chairman Johnson opened the afternoon session.

**Action/Presentation Items Continued**

**Claim for Compensation for Storing a Court Ordered Vehicle**

Performance Auto Sales Owner Bill Valdez was not present. County Attorney Brett Johnson was present and shared the background of this case. Following discussion, ***Commissioner West moved to deny paying the invoice. Commissioner Bailiff seconded the motion.*** The motion carried.

**Elected Official Salary Discussion**

Human Resource Director Garry McLean presented the Wyoming Elected Official salaries, effective through December 31, 2013, for Wyoming counties. Chairman Johnson spoke that this exhibit showed what all of the elected officials were earning throughout the state so that they could study, evaluate and make an informed decision. Human Resource Director Garry McLean noted that any changes would be effective the beginning of the 2015 election cycle. Chairman Johnson stressed that this was the beginning of their attempt to make a decision.

**Executive Session(s)-Personnel/Legal**

Chairman Johnson entertained a motion to enter into executive session for legal and personnel. ***Commissioner West moved to go into executive session to discuss legal issues. Commissioner Van Matre seconded the motion.*** The motion carried. A quorum of the commission was present.

After coming out of executive session, Chairman Johnson spoke that they would take an action based on a legal issue that was discussed. ***Commissioner Bailiff moved that, on this governmental claim for vehicle damage, the amount of \$2,161.81 be paid. Commissioner Van Matre seconded the motion.*** The motion carried.

**Adjourn**

There being no further business to come before the Board this day, the meeting was adjourned subject to the call of the Chairman.
