Commissioner Wendling reported that he attended meetings for the Farson Eden Waste Board, the Conservation District, the Wamsutter Town Council, the American Legion Archie Hay Post 24 Board, the Rock Springs McDonald's Ribbon Cutting Ceremony, and the WCCA Conference/Legislative Session and reception. Commissioner Wendling reported on his liaison meetings for the Star Board, Juvenile Detention Alternative Initiative Board, and Communities Protecting the Green Board. Commissioner Wendling explained that he drove to Granger to check the status of the water situation and expressed his appreciation to Commissioner West for the continued update on Granger.

**Chairman Johnson**

Chairman Johnson reported that he attended the WCCA Conference/Legislative Session and reception. Chairman Johnson provided a copy of a letter submitted to Governor Mead relative to Sweetwater County employment and budget reserve figures and expressed his appreciation to Human Resource Director Garry McLean for drafting the letter. Chairman Johnson addressed the importance of AML Funding. Chairman Johnson reported that he attended a Wyoming Public Lands Initiative (WPLI) meeting and recommended to opt out of the WPLI. Following discussion, Chairman Johnson entertained a motion to opt out of the current WPLI process as it is going forward with the WCCA. ***Commissioner Wendling so moved. Commissioner West seconded the motion.*** Following further discussion, the motion carried with Commissioner Kolb voting in opposition due to wanting a voice at the table. Chairman Johnson explained that he will be traveling to Cheyenne on February 17, 2016 to attend the WLCI meeting. Lastly, Chairman Johnson read a report from Facilities Manager Chuck Radosevich.

#### **Commissioner Van Matre**

Commissioner Van Matre reported that he attended the WCCA Conference/Legislative Session and reception. Commissioners Van Matre and Johnson expressed their appreciation to Senior Buyer Marilyn Nomis for always accommodating traveling needs for each commissioner. Commissioner Van Matre announced that Brigida (Brie) Blasi has taken over the Museum Director position. Commissioner Van Matre reported that he visited with the Parks and Recreation Board, Golden Hour Senior Citizen Center Director Sheila Schermetzler, VSO staff, IT Director Tim Knight, and Custodial Manager Karen Bailey.
