Commissioner Comments/Reports

Chairman Johnson

Chairman Johnson reported that he attended an Ozone Committee meeting in Sublette County and noted that there is resentment towards Sweetwater County for some of the air quality. Chairman Johnson attended a CLG meeting in Marbleton, Wyoming and spoke of the fire that is burning in that area. He recommended that Sweetwater County upgrade the Land Use Plan. Lastly, Chairman Johnson asked for board recommendations for the 6th cent committee and suggested there be a workshop.

Commissioner West

Commissioner West reported that he met with the Board of Health, Memorial Hospital Finance and Audit Committee and Southwest Counseling Service. Commissioner West requested an update on the building at 333 Broadway. Facilities Manager Chuck Radosevich explained that he spoke with entities requesting utilization of the building. Lastly, Commissioner West commented on the fire season and the concerns he has with the public being responsible considering the fire ban in place.

Commissioner Bailiff

Commissioner Bailiff reported that he attended a Travel and Tourism reception with Commissioner Van Matre. Also in attendance were legislators from around the state. Commissioner Bailiff explained that he toured the County Events Complex and spoke of the clear span structures. Commissioner Kolb
