### adult health services



**FOCUS:** Health improvement and maintenance for ages 19 and older

**SERVICES:**

- Well adult clinics
- Cholesterol screening and education
- Health maintenance home visits
- Case management and skilled nurse visits for the Home and Community Based Service (HCBS) waiver
- Personal care and respite care for the HCBS waiver



### home health services

**FOCUS:** Home care to improve health status and prevent further complications for people with acute and chronic health conditions

**SERVICES:**

- Skilled nursing visits
- Physical Therapy visits
- Occupational Therapy visits
- Home health aide personal care



### long term care assessment

**FOCUS:** Assure that our frail, elderly, and disabled adults are served in the best possible environment

**SERVICES:**

- Assessment for HCBS waiver eligibility
- Assessment for nursing home placement
- Assessment for continuation of Medicaid nursing home coverage

### maternal child health services



**FOCUS:** Health promotion, access to care, prevention services for birth to age 19, and pregnant and parenting families

**SERVICES:**

- Best Beginnings for Wyoming babies
- Nurse Family Partnership Program
- Postpartum calls and visits (Welcome Home)
- Parenting classes
- High risk maternal, infant, and child home visits
- Premature infant follow-up
- High risk pregnant and parenting teen visits
- Pregnancy testing and assistance with Medicaid eligibility
- Care coordination for children with special health care needs
- Dental and orthodontia assistance
- Hearing and vision screening
- Head Start screening
- Day care provider education

### communicable disease control



**FOCUS:** Reduce the occurrence of vaccine preventable diseases and curtail the spread of infectious diseases

**SERVICES:**

- Childhood and adult immunizations
- HIV/AIDS counseling and testing clinics
- HIV/AIDS education
- HIV/AIDS case management
- Investigation of communicable disease outbreaks
- Foreign Travel immunizations
- Tuberculosis testing and followup

### all hazards response preparedness



**FOCUS:** Assure agency readiness for the role it will play in response to environmental hazards, especially bioterrorism

**SERVICES:**

- Public education
- Coordination with other first responders
- Conduct exercises and training
- Active and passive surveillance of diseases
- 24/7 coverage
