



ATV Crash Under Investigation

July 30, 2018



A serious ATV crash near Green River Friday is under investigation, Sheriff Mike Lowell said on Monday.

Corporal Matt Bartolotta of the Sheriff's Office was dispatched at about 5:54 PM to the crash scene, about ½ mile north of the Green River Outdoor Rifle Shooting Range located on the Scott's Bottom Road.

Already on scene were officers of the Green River Police Department, Green River

firefighters, and emergency medical responders. Two people were involved in the crash - Kayla Vigil, 23, and 25-year-old David Clinton.

Vigil and Clinton are believed to have been riding their ATV up a steep slope when the vehicle rolled backwards. Clinton was transported to Memorial Hospital of Sweetwater County for treatment to his injuries, but Vigil was air-transported to Salt Lake City with serious head trauma.

The Sheriff's Office had no update on Vigil's condition as of press time.

UPDATE - July 31, 2018

According to information posted by family members on social media, Kayla's condition is improving, though she will likely have an extended hospital stay. The Sweetwater County Sheriff's Office extends to her our best wishes for a complete recovery.
